5/3/08 W 12 **STEVE FORBES** (anticipating Floyd rematch, handpicked technician Forbes, a former 130-lb champ, campaigning as a 140-47 lber. Oscar kept on the pressure, landing 31% of his 68 punches thrown per round. ***Oscar also landed an avg. of 10 of 34 jabs thrown over the last five rounds after failing to land his jab down the stretch vs. Mayweather.*** Oscar landed just 31% of his power shots vs. the slick Forbes- but hit hard enough to keep Forbes at bay. Forbes landed just 20% of his 65 total punches thrown per round. He did land 83 of 306 power shots (27%) enough to lump up the face of Oscar, who landed 126 of 404 power shots (31%). Scoring: 119-109 2x & 120-108.)

5/5/07 L 12 (spl) **FLOYD MAYWEATHER** (landed 140 of 646 total punches (22% -54 thrown per round) to 224 of 512 (44%) for Mayweather, who also landed 58% of his power shots (162 of 260) to 89 of 363 for Oscar. ***Oscar's jab accuracy disappeared down the stretch, as he landed just 18 of 149 (12%) in rounds 8 thru 12 after landing 33 of 135 (24%) in rounds 1 thru 7.*** Oscar landed better than 30% of his total punches in just 3 rounds, while Mayweather landed 60% or more of his power shots in 6 of 12 rounds. Judge Tommy Kaczmarek was impressed with Oscar's activity, scoring it 115-113 for the Golden Boy. Chuck Giampa scored it 116-112 Mayweather and Jerry Roth had it 115-113 Mayweather. ***Roth scored the last round for Mayweather, the only judge to do so. Had he scored the 12th for De La Hoya, the fight would have been a draw.***)



OSCAR DELAHOYA NOTES

5/6/06 KO 6 **RICARDO MAYORGA** (Outlanded bully Mayorga 116-58 in total punches, landing 44% of his power shots & jabs. Closed show by outlanding Mayorga 42-10 in total punches over last 2 rounds. Avg'd 50 total punches thrown per round and 20 jabs thrown per round. Mayorga down in 1st round and twice in sixth. Mayorga landed just 17% of his total punches.)

9/18/04 KO by 9 **BERNARD HOPKINS** (underdog for first time in career in challenge of Hopkins and his middleweight title. Landed just 82 of 315 total punches (26%) in 8 ½ rounds (an average of 37 thrown per round and 10 landed). The cautious Hopkins landed 99 of 361 (27%), but was coming on, as he outlanded Oscar 39-18 in power shots over the last 4 rounds. A well-placed body shot in 9th put Oscar, who pocketed at least \$30 million, down for the count. Scoring thru 8: 79-73 H; 78-74 H & 77-75 D (Keith McDonald).

6/5/04 W 12 **FELIX STURM** (outlanded 234-188 by unknown 20-0 Sturm, who seemed to enjoy every minute in there with Oscar. Oscar came out blazing throwing 103 punches in round one, most since his 113 in first round vs. Troy Dorsey in 8th pro fight. Averaged 85 per round in first 4 rounds, landing 25% vs. long-armed Sturm, who countered effectively throughout the fight. In fact, Sturm landed over 50% of his power punches in 7 of 12 rounds, including a whopping 71% (22 of 31) in round 11. Sturm landed 52% of his power shots for the fight vs. the stationary Oscar, who surely will be on his bicycle vs. Hopkins. Overall Oscar went 188 of 792 (24%) to 234 of 541 (43%) for Sturm, who outlanded Oscar 112-58 in jab department. Oscar had 130-122 edge in power connects, throwing 394 to Sturm's 235. Sturm's 234 connects second highest total landed vs. Oscar next to Mosley's 284 landed in their first fight. Scoring: 115-113 on all 3 cards.)

9/13/03 L 12 **SHANE MOSLEY** (another controversial fight, prompted by another Oscar fade down the stretch. Oscar, 2-1 favorite, landed 221 of 616 (36%) total punches (51 per round) to 127 of 496 (26%) for Mosley (41 per round). Oscar's statistical edge was bolstered by jab-he landed 106 of 296 (36%) to just 33 of 268 (12%) for Mosley. Oscar had only a 115-94 edge in power connects, with Mosley landing 41% to Oscar's 36% and Mosley clearly landed the harder shots, especially down the stretch. Despite a 113-51 Oscar edge in connects thru first 6 rounds, one judge had fight even thru 6. (Oscar had only 46-35 edge in power connects thru 6) After landing an average of 11 of 29 jabs per round in rounds 1-8, Oscar landed just 6 of 20 in rounds 8-12, as Mosley's power numbers doubled, **landing an average of 11 of 26 over the last 5 rounds. He rocked Oscar in 9th and had him holding on in 11th & 12th. Scoring 115-113 on all 3 cards.**

5/3/03 KO 7 **YORY BOY CAMPAS** (only Oscar (and maybe Tyson) could generate \$12-15 million payday in "exhibition". Outlanded the absorbent Campas 264-75 in total punches, landing 53%, while limiting Campas to connect pct. Of just 22%.)

9/14/02 KO 11 **FERNANDO VARGAS** (major grudge fight. Vargas possessed "Body by Jake"(which later translated into steroid use). Vargas stronger earlier, outlanding Oscar 86-29 in power shots thru first 5 rounds. Oscar ahead on 2 cards thru 10 rounds, 96-94 Paul Smith; 96-94 Doug Tucker. Patricia Jarman Manning had Vargas ahead 97-94. Oscar rallied in rounds 6-8, winning all 3 on Smith & Tucker's cards, outlanding Vargas, who seemed to hit the wall in those rounds, 79-45.



OSCAR DELAHOYA NOTES

After a Vargas rally in round 9 (he outlanded Oscar 41-26, including 32-13 in power shots, Oscar dropped Vargas late in round 10 and finished him in 11th. Overall, Oscar landed 281 of 660 (43%), including 39 jabs per round. Vargas went 227 of 525 (43%)-just 48 total punches per round.)

6/23/01 W 12 **JAVIER CASTILLEJO** (joined 400-plus club (landed 403 punches vs. tough guy Castillejo who was ko'd just once in 55 fights.) Won 154-lb title, his fourth in 4th different weight class. Threw 28 jabs per round and averaged 62 punches per round. After Castillejo went distance, many wondered where Oscar's punching power was at 154 lbs...the questions were answered vs. Vargas)

6/17/00 L 12 (spl) **SHANE MOSLEY** (lost welterweight title. Looked for high-profile fight after Trinidad retirement. Went ko-crazy vs. "smaller" Mosley (who actually has longer reach than Oscar and also outweighed him). Shane dominated 7-12, winning all but 11th on 1 card. The 9-5 favorite delahoya, needing the last round to earn a draw, was outlanded 45-18 by Shane, the most punches ever landed vs. Oscar in a round. Mosley landed an incredible 57% of his power shots over 12 rounds. Oscar avg'd only 23 jabs per round, Mosley 31 jabs per. Overall, Oscar landed 257 of 716 (36%) to 284 of 678 (42%) for Mosley, the most punches ever landed against Oscar.

9/18/99 L 12 (maj) **FELIX TRINIDAD** (welterweight unification title fight turned track meet as fatigued Oscar backpedaled last quarter of fight, losing last 4 rounds on one card, (115-113 T), 3 of last 4 on another card (115-114) and 4 of last 5 on third card (114-114). Oscar threw 16 more punches per round and landed 100 more jabs with power punches even and Trinidad coming forward all fight-sounds like Mosley II.)

2/13/99 W 12 (spl) **IKE QUARTEY** (both down in 6th. With fight in balance, Oscar stormed out in 12th and dropped Ike. Arm-weary Oscar couldn't finish off Quartey, who was soundly beaten by Fernando Vargas 14 months later.)

4/12/97 W 12 **PERNELL WHITAKER** (counter-puncher's delight, as they both threw less than 50 punches per round. Oscar landed 191 of 557 (34%) to 232 of 582 (40%) for Whitaker, who had 160-45 edge in jab connects. Oscar down for flash in 9th. Pete lost point in 3rd for low blow. Scoring: 115-111 D; 116-110 D; 116-110 D.)

6/28/08 KO 9 **DAVID DIAZ** (Pac Man, who won his first title at 112 lbs., moved up to lightweight to challenge for Diaz's title. Answered any questions about weight gain with sizzling performance. Landed **30% of his 88 punches thrown per round**. Also landed 37 % of his power shots (180 of 490-**54 power shots thrown per round**). The blitzed Diaz managed to land just 19% of his total punches. Manny landed 35 of 114 punches in round two; 32 of 84 in round five and 36 of 100 in round eight before the dropping Diaz at in the ninth. The fight was stopped at 2:24 of the ninth.)

3/15/08 W 12 (spl) **JM MARQUEZ** (rematch of controversial 5/8/04 draw. Dropped Marquez in round three. Overall, Marquez landed 172 of 511 (34%) total punches to 157 of 619 (25%) for Pac Man. Marquez also had a 130-114 edge in power connects, landing 42% to Manny's 37%. Scoring: 115-112 P; 114-113 P; 115-112 M.)

10/6/07 W 12 **MARCO A. BARRERA** (outlanded the passive Barrera 256-120 in total punches. Manny landed 37% of his 58 total punches thrown per round. Manny didn't have to step on the gas, as Barrera avg'd just 48 total punches thrown per round and landed just 81 power shots all night. Manny landed 54% of his power shots (176 of 325). Pac Man outlanded Barrera 309-172 in first fight. Scoring of rematch: 115-112; 118-109 2x.)

4/14/07 KO 8 **JORGE SOLIS** (Manny heated up in round six after getting cut over his left eye from an accidental clash of heads. Pac landed just 25% of his power shots over first five rounds- due to the awkward and not-busy (49 total punches thrown per round) style of Solis, 30-0-2. Pac Man landed 48% of his power shots in rounds six, seven and eight, including 51% in sixth (27 of 53). Solis was down twice in 8th, the second time for the count.)



MANNY PACQUIAO NOTES

11/18/06 KO 3 **ERIK MORALES** (blew away “El Terrible” in rubber match. Closed show by landing 51 of 71 power shots (72%) in third round. Outlanded Morales 73-25 in power shots in rounds two and three combined.)

7/2/06 W 12 **OSCAR LARIOS** (triumphant return to Philippines vs. former 122-lb. champ Larios successful- in same arena where 31 years earlier Muhammad Ali ko’d Joe Frazier in The Thrilla in Manilla. Larios held his own in early rounds, rocking Pac Man several times in 3rd. Late in 3rd a Pac right hook opened up Larios’ left eye and the beat down was on. The game Larios was down in 7th & 12th. Scoring: 117-110; 118-108; 120-106.)

1/21/06 KO 10 **ERIK MORALES** (Pac Man sought revenge from decision loss to El Terrible 10 months earlier. Morales 6-5 favorite. First five rounds replay of first fight, as Morales controlled fight with jab and had a 107-84 edge in total connects. Morales up by a point on 2 judges cards thru 5 and ahead by 3 points on third card. Pac Man did invest in the body early and that attack began paying dividends in the sixth, as Manny outlanded Morales 32-8 in power shots. The route was on. Morales, unable to hold off Pacquiao any longer, landed just 20 jabs over the last 4 rounds. He was down in the 9th, before the end came at 2:33 of the 10th after Manny had a 18-5 edge in power connects in 10th and a 103-45 edge in power connects after 5th round. Morales was stopped for the first time in his 52-fight, nearly 14-yr. career.)

9/10/05 KO 6 **HECTOR VELAZQUEZ** (showcased on undercard of Morales-Raheem. Held up his end of the deal, blowing away Velazquez, 42-10-2, in 6th round. Outlanded Velazquez 130-59 over last 4 rounds, averaging 83 punches thrown. Closed show by landing 40 of 98 in 6th, including 37 of 85 power shots.)

3/19/05 L 12 **ERIK MORALES** (pick’em fight, controlled by naturally bigger man Morales, who landed 265 of 714 (37%) total punches (60 per round) to 217 of 894 (24% -75 per round) for Pac Man. Morales showed his versatility, outjabbing the southpaw 96-34, averaging 25 per round to 29 per round for Pac, who landed just 10%. Morales also landed 41% of his power shots (169 of 411) to 183 of 545 (34%) for Pac, who was cut badly over right eye in 5th round. Morales outlanded Pac 120-82 in rounds 4 thru 8, winning 4 of those 5 frames on all cards. Morales, wanting to add some “flavor” to his performance, even turned southpaw in round 12 and landed 25 of 69 total punches. Pac had his best round in the 12th, landing 31 of 99 total punches, including 25 of 62 power shots. Too little too late, as the scorecards read 115-113 Morales across the board.)

5/8/04 D 12 **JUAN MANUEL MARQUEZ** (dropped Marquez three times in 1st round. Judges Jutras (115-110 M) and John Stewart (115-110 P) scored that round 10-6. Other Burt Clements (113-113) scored it 10-7, unaware he could have went 10-6. It cost Pacquiao a majority decision win. Pac Man avg’d 75 punches in rounds 1 & 2-then fought at a more Marquez-like pace of 40 per round over next 10 rounds-a credit to Marquez. Jutras, who scored 115-110 Marquez, gave Marquez the second round despite landing just 8 of 45 total punches to 18 of 77 for Pacquiao. Overall Pac Man went 148 of 639 (23%) to 158 of 547 (29%) for Marquez, who had a 122-100 edge in power connects, throwing 339 to Pac’s 231.)



11/15/03 KO 11 **MARCO A. BARRERA** (4-1 'dog Pac Man devoured Barrera, outlanding JC Superstar 309-172 in total punches. Landed 45% of his power punches. Applied constant pressure, *averaging 76 punches per round, landing 30 or more punches in 6 of 11 rounds.* Overall went 309 of 838 (37%) to 172 of 547 (31%) for Barrera. Kennedy McKinney landed 359 punches vs. Barrera, the most landed vs. Marco in 18 of his fights tracked by CompuBox. Manny down for questionable knockdown in 1st. Barrera down in 3rd and 11th. Scoring thru 10 rounds: 97-90; 97-90; 97-89.)
